This staff satisfaction survey was created by Gallup in 1998. These 13 questions have been validated and tested with 24 industries and 2500 businesses sites (include not-for-profit agencies). Use this survey as a pre- and post-test to improve staff satisfaction at your workplace. Note: these questions are validated and will not be so if you change the wording. Many organizations that administer the survey wish to change question #10; however, research shows that individuals that have a best friend at work are happier and more productive.
