

DERBYSHIRE CONSTABULARY

NOTIFICATION OF TRANSFER OF FIREARM/SHOTGUN

Whenever a shotgun or firearm is transferred from one person to another, including to and from Dealers, **both parties** must inform the police within SEVEN DAYS of the date of transaction and forward the complete form by post or fax to :-

Firearms Licensing, Police Headquarters, Butterley Hall, Ripley, Derbyshire, DE5 3RS

The only time when this is not necessary is when a gun is transferred to a Registered Firearms Dealer for temporary storage or repair or when a shotgun is loaned to another shotgun certificate holder for a period of no longer than 72 hours.

NOTE: IT IS AN OFFENCE, FOR WHICH YOU MAY BE PROSECUTED, NOT TO NOTIFY THE DISPOSAL OR ACQUISITION OF A FIREARM OR SHOTGUN
