**C. Eligibility Information**

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1) The amount of Federal Pell Grant funds you may receive over your lifetime is limited by a new federal law to be the equivalent of six years of Pell Grant funding. 2) Once you have attempted 30 units at all colleges you must submit a MAP (My Academic Plan) to the Financial Assistance Office to be considered for financial aid. Students are required to make an appointment with an Academic Counselor to complete a MAP well before the start of the semester as counselor schedules fill up quickly. If you have prior academic units to be applied to your degree objective at Saddleback College, you must have official transcripts on file with Saddleback College Admissions & Records Office, so counselors can include in your MAP.

3) In order to qualify for federal or state financial aid, you must have a clear educational goal (Transfer, A.A., A.S. or Certificate of Achievement) at Saddleback College. Your educational goal will be verified on MySite. You can update your Educational Goal status with the Admissions and Records Office (as only degree-seeking, Certificate of Achievement seeking, or transfer students; are generally eligible for federal and state financial aid). If you receive your Award Letter but for some reason change your Educational Goal to an "Ineligible" goal, you will not be eligible for any future financial aid disbursements.

4) Saddleback College is required, by law, to establish a Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy (SAP).
