



## Short Form Health Survey

(SF 8, SF 12, SV 36, SV-36v2, SV-12v2)

<b>Measurement / Scales</b>	Measures quality of life, functional health and well-being; 2 major scales physical health and mental health broken down to 8 scales including physical functioning, role-physical, bodily pain, general health, vitality, social functioning, role emotional, mental. 12 item test has same scales with less precision. The 8 item survey which includes only 1 item per scale is used for large scale studies monitoring population health.
<b>Applicable Population</b>	14 years old and older
<b>Standardized Tool</b>	Normative data, reliability & validity established
<b>Normative Data / Database</b>	Extensive data with over 76 million surveys administered
<b>Publisher</b>	Quality Metric
<b>Administration</b>	Self-administered paper-and-pencil, computerized administration, or via trained interviewer
<b>Time to Administer</b>	5-10 minutes
<b>Ease of Use / Number of Items</b>	36 items or 12 item short form
<b>Owner of Data</b>	Quality Metrics
