



Short Form Health Survey

(SF 8, SF 12, SV 36, SV-36v2, SV-12v2)

Measurement / Scales	Measures quality of life, functional health and well-being; 2 major scales physical health and mental health broken down to 8 scales including physical functioning, role-physical, bodily pain, general health, vitality, social functioning, role emotional, mental. 12 item test has same scales with less precision. The 8 item survey which includes only 1 item per scale is used for large scale studies monitoring population health.
