All men who are United States citizens and non-citizens who reside in the United States, aged 18–25, are required to register with the Selective Service System. A man who resides in the U.S. as a lawful nonimmigrant isn't required to register as long as he maintains a lawful visa status. Students who are required to register with the Selective Service must do so to be eligible for federal financial aid funds. For more information visit www.sss.gov.

- ☐ I am female. (Check your FAFSA to confirm that you answered that you are female and if not make a correction.)
- ☐ I am a male currently in the armed services and on active duty (this exception does not apply to members of the Reserve and National Guard who are not on active duty).
- ☐ I am a male who is not yet 18 at the time I am completing my application.
- ☐ I am a male born before 1960.
- ☐ I am a citizen of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Federated States of Micronesia.
- ☐ I am a non-citizen who first entered the U.S. after I turned 26.

NOTE: If a male immigrant can provide proof that he first entered the U.S. when he was past registration age, he is not required to be registered or provide a Status Information Letter. The students' entry documentation is sufficient to demonstrate he was not required to register.

- ☐ I am a non-citizen who entered the U.S. as a lawful non-immigrant on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. under the terms of that visa until I turned 26.
- ☐ I was not required to register prior to meeting one of the criteria below and met this criterion for the entire time through the age of 25 and therefore qualify for a waiver.
- ☐ I was unable to register due to being hospitalized, incarcerated, or institutionalized.
- ☐ I was enrolled in any officer procurement program at The Citadel, North Georgia College and State University, Norwich University, Virginia Military Institute, Texas A&M University, or Virginia Polytechnic and State University; or I was a commissioned Public Health Service officer on active duty or a member of the Reserve of the Public Health Service on specified active duty.

If you are not required to register, you must provide documentation to the Financial Aid Office of your status. Documentation for exempt noncitizens includes: proof of birth date on a passport, birth certificate, or U.S. driver's license or state ID; proof of immigration date into the U.S. from an entry date stamp on the I-94 Form or in the passport, or a letter from the USCIS indicating the entry date; and, for those here on a valid visa who are at least 18 and less than 26 years old, a student visa form (I-20) or other valid U.S. passport visa stamp with expiration date (the dates must be from entry until after the man turned 26).
