



Dispatch Center Consolidated Feasibility Studies

Request Form

Background

In an effort to support regional consolidation efforts, Cuyahoga County has partnered with Cleveland State University to provide feasibility study services to municipalities within Cuyahoga County who are interested in exploring the consolidation of their dispatch center services.

This is an ongoing service and requests will be reviewed and considered on a first-come, first-serve, on-going basis until further notice. Feasibility studies are anticipated to last 6 months barring any delays due to collection and clarification of data, meetings and interviews.

Requirements

In accordance with the County's goals, the following are required to participate in the feasibility studies:

- A minimum of 3 municipalities; maximum of 6 municipalities
- Police and Fire/EMS from each municipality are required to participate
- Explore a full consolidation
- Identify a single Point of Contact to represent the group
- Participate/assign staff to participate in initial planning meeting
- Participate/assign staff to participate in interviews to obtain data
- Provide all data and documentation requested by a date to be determined
