- 9.3** All clubs must submit BFNL registrations form for players, club officials and coaches to the BFNL Administrators one week prior to the commencement of the first home and away match. Additional registrations will only be accepted if they are submitted to the BFNL Administrators at least 24 hours prior to game day, on the appropriate forms (BFNL and VNA) and accompanied with VNA forms if necessary. No new player registrations will be accepted after 30th June in the current year.

Please read all of the information provided below before signing the 2016 Bendigo Football Netball League (BFNL) Player Registration Form.

All players participating in the 2016 Bendigo Football Netball League (BFNL) competition are required to sign a BFNL Player Registration Form to confirm their intention to play in 2016.

Players Please Note:

By signing the BFNL Player Registration Form you agree to

1. Be registered for the 2016 BFNL Competition with the nominated BFNL Club
2. Only register with one BFNL Club for the 2016 BFNL Competition.
3. Notify BFNL Administrators in writing providing full details of circumstances which may require you to request a clearance to play for another BFNL Club after registering with the initial BFNL Club.

Any move would be subject to the approval of Bendigo Football Netball League and only as a result of extenuating circumstances.

9. AFFILIATIONS, REGISTRATIONS, ACCREDITATION AND CLEARANCES

- 9.3 All clubs must submit BFNL Registration Forms for players, club officials and coaches (including Assistant Coaches) to the BFNL Manager one week prior to the commencement of the first home and away match. Additional registrations will only be accepted if they are submitted to the BFNL Manager at least 24 hours prior to game day, on the appropriate forms (BFNL and VNA) and accompanied with VNA forms if necessary. No new player or coach registrations will be accepted after 30th June in the current year.
- 9.4 If a registration form is not lodged within seven (7) days of signing, a player may sign with another club and, if the Registration Form is forwarded to the BFNL Manager by the second club prior to a Registration Form being received from the first club, the registration form first received shall be accepted.
- 9.5 All clubs must submit Netball Victoria Registration Sheets and all monies in the prescribed format to the BFNL Manager no later than one week prior to the commencement of the first home and away match.
- 9.6 Any player that has been registered by a Club, but no longer wishes to play for that Club, must obtain a Clearance prior to the 30th June from the club before playing with another Club within this League. All players' registrations expire at the end of BFNL netball home and away and finals season.
- 9.7 Players wishing to transfer from one BFNL club to another during the current playing season must, fully complete a clearance application which is to be lodged with the BFNL Manager and current club. The club has seven (7) days to respond to a clearance application and if the club fails to respond within 7 days then the clearance is automatically granted and the BFNL Manager will inform the player. If the club refuses the application the player has the right of appeal to the Board within seven (7) days of refusal. On receipt of the players appeal, the Board or League Administrator or their designated representative shall organise the Hearing of such appeal.
- 9.8 Playing an unregistered player or a player who has failed to gain a clearance will result in the following penalties:
 - (a) \$150 fine per offending player and loss of four (4) premiership points for each occasion in which an unregistered player takes part in a match and any percentage obtained from those matches.
- 9.9 The BFNL Board of Management may set limits upon the number of registrations and/or clearances that any one club may get from any source.
