The marks for the Group Coursework will be distributed on the basis of this peer assessment. The peer assessment marks are used as a modifier of the marks awarded for this coursework.

Before the submission deadline, each group should discuss how their work on the Coursework was organized and allocated between them. This should form the basis for their peer assessment on the **relative** contribution of each member to the Coursework task.

One assessment sheet per group is to be signed and dated by all group members and posted in the appropriate coursework box in the George Begg Building by Friday 21st November 2014.

Criteria

Please rate the **relative** contribution of each group member and give a mark, (whole numbers only) on a scale **from 0 to 5** in accordance with the following criteria.

- **5** indicates an outstanding performance involving exceptional quantity or quality of contribution.
- **4** indicates a significantly greater than average but not exceptional contribution to the group's work.
- **3** indicates an average contribution of average value to other members of the group.
- **2** indicates a below average but acceptable contribution to the group's work.
- **1** indicates an inadequate and unsatisfactory level of contribution to the group's work.
- **0** indicates no meaningful contribution.

Your marking is likely to show a spread of marks with most marks awarded likely to be 3s and 4s – it is only in truly exceptional circumstances you will be awarding a mark of 5.
