**Behavioral Guidelines for Sunday School**  
**(Not necessary for Youth Group members)**  
First Parish in Lincoln 2010/2011

Our intention is to provide a safe and positive environment for everyone involved in the Religious Education program. We have established covenants for the children and youth in the church and each class will establish class rules and appropriate consequences for not respecting the rules at the beginning of the program year. As a last resort, the natural consequence of being disruptive or unsafe in class will be that the child's parents will be asked to leave church to attend to their child. **Every child must have a parent or adult responsible for her/him on the church grounds. If you will not be at church, please tell us who is responsible for your child.**

In the event that any child has difficulty participating in a class, and his/her behavior becomes aggressive or disruptive and interferes with another child's experience:

- 1) The Teacher will respectfully remind the student that the behavior is not appropriate and request and encourage the child to join in the class activities. The child will be reminded of the class' covenant with each other to create a safe, supportive learning environment.
- 2) If a child does not respond to verbal requests, s/he will be brought to the office of the Director of Religious Education or the parents will be asked to leave church to help with the situation.
- 3) If disruptive or aggressive behavior becomes a continuing issue with a given child, a contract may be created with the parents, RE Director and the child before they reenter the class. Contracts will include agreed-upon expected behavior, and class time out limits if needed.

In the event my child requires emergency medical attention, and I cannot be reached immediately, I give permission for the First Parish youth leaders to authorize medical attention.

I agree that The First Parish in Lincoln, its officers, board members, supervisors, agents, servants and/or employees have the right to terminate the participation of my child in any or all church sponsored activities for failure to behave and act in accordance with the church's regulations on conduct, for failure to follow the instructions and directions of the activity supervisor(s) and/or chaperone(s), or for any conduct of my child deemed by the church, its officers, board members, supervisors, agents, servants and/or employees, in their sole discretion to be detrimental to or incompatible with the interest, harmony, comfort or welfare of others or the activity as a whole.

I further agree to indemnify The First Parish in Lincoln, its officers, board members, supervisors, agents, servants and/or employees for any and all damage or injury my child may cause to others as a result of his/her participation in the church sponsored event.
