

Guest Event Recording Consent Form

This form is to be signed by each person who has agreed to be recorded and filmed as the principal party to, or as part of, an event carried out within the University of Kent. The purpose of this form is to seek consent for the films and/or recordings to be taken and subsequently to be used in a number of media, including the intranet/web by the University of Kent. The University of Kent in turn offers a commitment to only allow said recordings to be used appropriately and sensitively for educational purposes.

I, the undersigned, agree to being recorded in audio/video format by the University of Kent.

I confirm that where material is included in the recording which is the intellectual property, including copyright, of another party, I have either: (a) secured permission to include the materials in my presentation, including permission to record such material¹, or (b) determined that statutory exceptions (e.g. fair dealing) apply to my use of the third party material (for more information please visit www.kent.ac.uk/copyright).

I understand that any copyright or other intellectual property which arises in the recording² belongs to the University of Kent and that the recording may be used by the University of Kent for any purposes required as per the University's IP Policy³.
