

MINOR TRAVEL CONSENT FORM

{Required for those under 18 traveling without both or just one parent}

Some international travel regulations require a notarized Minor Travel Consent Form for minors to be permitted on international flights without both parents/guardians. This form gives authorities and foreign officials proof that a minor has consent from his or her parent(s) or guardian(s) to travel with an adult who is not a relative. It is meant to prevent hassle, delay, and cancellation at each checkpoint in the travel process.
