We are excited to announce the formation of The eStem Elementary School Student Council! Student Council gives students the opportunity to develop leadership skills, experience the democratic process, plan and perform service projects to benefit the school and the community, and encourage and maintain a cooperative spirit within the student body.

Who:

1. The eStem Student Council will consist of one representative from each classroom (2nd-4th). These representatives will be elected within their own classrooms on Election Day, Friday, September 16th. The student receiving the majority of votes will be the class representative.
2. The officers will be elected by the student body on Friday, September 16th and include:
 - President (4th grade position)
 - Vice-President (3rd or 4th grade position)
 - Secretary (3rd or 4th grade position)
 - Historian (3rd or 4th grade position)
3. A student who wishes to be a candidate for the student council should:
 - Be a good citizen – follow all school rules.
 - Be a hardworking responsible student.
 - Get along well with other students and adults.
 - Be excited about helping our school and community.
 - Be able to attend the meetings.

When & Where:

Student Council meetings will take place the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of every month from 3:30-4:30 in the computer lab.

How:

Students who are interested in serving on the student council must fill out the attached application form and turn it in to his/her teacher by Friday, September 9th. Please note that a parent and the classroom teacher must sign the application. Students running for officer positions will meet with the student council sponsors, Coach Beavert and Miss Molinaro, to discuss the rules for campaigning during Election Week (September 12th-16th). The candidates will present a 1-2 minute speech to the student body over the Montage on September 15th about what makes them a good candidate.
