Some University of Toronto awards require the recipient to be an Ontario resident who is able to demonstrate financial need, in addition to other selection criteria. All students who are Ontario residents are requested to submit this form to ensure that an accurate assessment of financial need can be made.

Ontario residency is defined as follows:

To be eligible, students must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents and satisfy one of the following criteria:

- 1) student has always resided in Ontario or
- 2) Ontario is the last province that the student has resided in for 12 consecutive months without being a full-time post-secondary student
- 3) Student who is considered married for OSAP purposes can be considered an Ontario resident if the student's partner has resided in Ontario for at least 12 consecutive months immediately before the last day of the month in which classes began for the student's most recent period of full-time post-secondary studies and during this time, the student's partner was not enrolled in full-time post secondary studies.
- 4) a single dependent student can be considered an Ontario resident if the student's parent(s), step-parents(s), legal guardian(s), or official sponsor(s) has resided in Ontario for at least 12 consecutive months immediately before the last day of the month in which classes began for the student's most recent period of full-time post secondary studies.

Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act

Personal information that you provide to the University is collected pursuant to section 2(14) of the University of Toronto Act, 1971.
