- A copy of the most recent standardized test score(s) administered within the last calendar year. Acceptable standardized test scores include: NWEA/MAP, Terra Nova, ACT, SAT or any other nationally normed standardized test.
- Student Questionnaire
- Two letters of recommendation from a teacher within the last calendar year
- A school profile
- The attached conduct report completed by a school official and must be returned in a sealed envelope
