<p>Lesson Preparation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> The day's objectives promote higher order thinking/habits of mind (analysis, problem-solving, evaluation, creation, synthesis); <input type="checkbox"/> Resources/materials allow for differentiation according to interest and skill; <input type="checkbox"/> Learning strategies are explicitly identified/taught as the way to learn the new material. <input type="checkbox"/> A number of higher-order questions will be explored during the lesson 		
<p>Launch (20% of the Lesson):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Background Knowledge is built by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activating prior knowledge/experience? • Introducing new content/vocabulary • Explicitly teaching a learning strategy/habit of mind?; <input type="checkbox"/> A Model is presented that set students up for the investigation work they will undertake; <input type="checkbox"/> The plan for the investigation session is communicated to students in at least 2 modes (spoken, written, visual). 		
<p>Investigate (60% of the Lesson):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Tasks allow for differentiation and individualization, by students or the teacher; <input type="checkbox"/> There are opportunities for students to investigate how to use new skills, content, and strategies / habits learned in the launch; <input type="checkbox"/> There are opportunities for students to explain how they undertook the investigation; <input type="checkbox"/> Students will interact with each other <input type="checkbox"/> The investigation requires analysis, evaluation and synthesis. <input type="checkbox"/> There is scaffolding so students can undertake the investigation independently. <input type="checkbox"/> There is an opportunity to check for student understanding 		
<p>Synthesize (20% of the Lesson):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> The assessment is tightly linked to the day's objectives, as well as the learning strategy; <input type="checkbox"/> The assessment is designed to help the teacher identify gaps in student learning, to support preparation for the next day; <input type="checkbox"/> The assessment requires higher-order thinking; <input type="checkbox"/> Students have an opportunity to describe how they used the learning strategies/habits of mind to learn what they learned; <input type="checkbox"/> Students have an opportunity to reflect on the content of what they learned, bringing together the ideas into a coherent synthesis.
