

Federal Student Loan Default Clearance Form

The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) indicates that you are in DEFAULT on a federal student loan. You are not eligible to receive any federal student aid until your default has been resolved.

To show you are out of default, you must attach a letter from the agency described below for your loan type. All letters must be on the letterhead from the agency and must contain language certifying that you are out of default and the type of loan that has cleared default. If you are in default on multiple loans you must provide letters for each loan type.

Consolidation Loan	Agency that guarantees the loan
Direct Loan	U.S. Department of Education
Federal Stafford Loan	Agency that guarantees the loan
Perkins Loan	School that disbursed the loan
