DeLaSalle High School Dance Rules and Procedure

- To attend a DeLaSalle dance, a guest must be at least 9th grade student, no older than 20 years of age, and accompanied by his/her DeLaSalle host.
- Student or state-issued ID's are required for admittance of DeLaSalle students and all guests.
- Once a student has been admitted to the dance, there is no re-admittance. Students who leave the dance early will be asked to sign-out. In some circumstances, the parent may be called and notified.
- All regular school rules of behavior will be enforced at dances. Everyone attending a DeLaSalle dance must conduct him/herself in a positive and respectful manner.
- Students will stay within the designated dance area of the school. (Student lockers will not be accessible)
- Students are expected to dress appropriately and adhere to DeLaSalle's dress code. A violation of the dress code may result in not being allowed into the dance.
- Beverage bottles and/or containers may not be brought into the dance.
- Use or possession of alcohol or illegal substances is strictly forbidden.
- Rules for appropriate dancing will be enforced. If a student does not respond cooperatively to a chaperone's request to dance appropriately, the student will be escorted out of the dance. No refund or admission will be given.
- At the end of the dance, students must leave school promptly following the dance. Ride arrangements should be made prior to attending the dance.
