**HOW TO REGISTER:** **NEW this year! Online registration. Go to: [campcolonycreek.com](http://campcolonycreek.com)**

1. Complete basic registration and payment online.
2. Complete the required fillable forms in this packet. **TYPE IN** all information and **PRINT**.
3. Parent/guardian must **SIGN** each form.
4. Mail or deliver to the address below. To avoid a \$15 Late Fee, registrations **MUST BE RECEIVED BY** Wednesday, May 15, 2019.

**E-mailed paperwork will NOT be accepted.**

Registration is considered complete when ALL required paperwork & payment are received.

- ➔ **CAMPER/Tag:** Complete the **Registration Form for Girl Campers & 'TAGs'**.
- ➔ **OLDER GIRL PROGRAM WORKSHOP LEADER** (Senior and Ambassador Scouts): Girls going in to 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade (Fall 2019) volunteer as workshop leaders to help younger girls earn badges. Complete the **Individual Registration Form for Program Aides**.
- ➔ **PROGRAM AIDE** (Cadettes): Girls going into 8<sup>th</sup> grade (Fall 2019) serve as *trained* Program Aides (must have LIA) assisting Older Girl Workshop Leaders and/or Adult Workshop Leaders with various camp workshops. Complete the **Individual Registration Form for Program Aides**.
- ➔ **ADULT VOLUNTEER:** Complete the **ADULT VOLUNTEER APPLICATION**.

**NEW OR FORMER GIRL SCOUTS:** If your camper is not a current member of Girl Scouts, please register her online ([gssjc.org](http://gssjc.org)). Follow the steps described on Page 2 of this packet.

Campers are placed in workshops in order of the following priority:

- PLACEMENT:**
1. Girl Scouts accompanied by an adult volunteering all 3 days—**Please volunteer!**
  2. All remaining Girl Scouts with accurate and complete camper registrations.
  3. Maximum registration of 330 Campers and Program Aides.

**CONFIRMATION:** Confirmation of registration will be emailed to individuals when registration is determined complete. Notice of an incomplete registration will be sent by email. Additional messages with camp information (emergency contact info, an optional meal plan, camper attire, supplies, and vehicle idling/parking restrictions) will be sent by email closer to the start of camp.

**REFUNDS:** All fees except \$10.00 are refunded *after* camp ends provided the Director receives written cancellation prior to Tuesday, June 4, 2019.

Registration is complete when ALL required paperwork has been received.

Please do NOT wait until the first day of camp to turn in paperwork.

If you are not a current member of Girl Scouts USA, please register online ([gssjc.org](http://gssjc.org)).

1. Parents with an already registered girl member should go to <https://gsmembers.force.com/members/login> to access their GSUSA family account (linked to your daughter's registration). Register as a 'Friends and Family' volunteer member in your daughter's troop.
2. Adults who do not have a family account linked to a registered girl, should follow the prompts to 'Join Today' on our council's website ([gssjc.org](http://gssjc.org)) and select the 'unsure' option. Type 'Troop 316571' in the pop-up window and continue the registration process.
3. *Please note:* The current membership fee for the remainder of the 2019 year, ending 9/30/2019 is **\$25.00**. As of May 1, 2019, an extended membership option will be offered for 17 months of GSUSA membership, ending 9/30/2020, for **\$35.00**. This is a new option for 1st time members joining during the summer months.
4. *Please print and submit the confirmation email received following completion of registration with the required camp registration forms.*

>> Please consider volunteering the full evening hours as this provides consistency for the young girls and ensures camp is not shut down due to poor adult-to-girl safety ratios.

All non-Girl Scout children of camp volunteers are called "**TAGS**".

- TAGS may attend only when their camp-volunteer parent is at camp.
- All TAGS must be potty-trained. Girls going into Kindergarten and younger. Boys, grade 5 and younger.
- Each TAG requires their own registration and Medical Information forms, complete with immunization and insurance card info.
- There is a \$6 per child, *per day* fee. The fee covers program supplies but not a t-shirt. Please use the camper registration form to purchase the optional TAG t-shirt & patch for \$7.50.

Prior to volunteering, adults must complete **all** of the following criteria for Girl Scouts and the state of Texas. Some volunteers already have completed the requirements, so just check them off! For other volunteers, these requirements are new and must be completed ASAP – as a missed deadline may mean you will not be able to volunteer at camp. We are aware some items are repetitious but it must be done for the protection of the children. 1. **Current GSUSA Adult Member** –GSUSA membership required for all Girl Scout volunteers working with girls or handling Girl Scout funds. (If re-registering, be sure to use your name previously used to avoid confusion.) Membership costs and options stated on page 2 of the Adult Volunteer Packet. *Please print and submit the confirmation email received following completion of registration with the other volunteer forms.*
2. **Background Check, GSSJC F-39** This is required for all camp volunteers. New camp volunteers registering in the 'Friends and Family' category will be asked to agree to a background check. GSSJC will update when necessary.
3. **Texas Child Protection – Abuse Issues Training & Examination** – This training will be available starting May 1. Completed *online* through the GSSJC website, access is through the volunteer's MyGS account. *After completing the online training and quiz, please print the completion certificate for your records and send a copy with your other volunteer forms.* \*The Texas certification is mandatory every TWO years. Returning volunteers will be contacted if an update is needed. Child abuse trainings from other organizations will not be accepted.
4. **Camp Colony Creek 2019 Adult Volunteer Application** -- *Please mail to the Camp Registrar*
5. **Adult Volunteer Emergency slip, GSSJC F-22** This provides information needed if something were to happen to any adult volunteer during camp. The information you provide is related to YOU (not your camper/TAG). Use page 5 of this packet.
