**DNA CONSUMPTION FORM LETTER**

Please note that some types of evidence may be consumed during the course of DNA analysis. When possible, the Louisiana State Police Crime Lab (LSPCL) DNA analysts will make every effort to preserve the evidence and/or an extract thereof. Because of the possibility that full consumption of DNA evidence may occur, the LSPCL requires that the submitting agency acknowledge this and provide authorization to consume the evidence when needed. If written permission is not received within thirty (30) days of submission of the evidence, the case may be closed and evidence returned unless sufficient justification is provided.

In addition, it is the responsibility of the submitting agency to determine their authority to authorize such consumption. In some instances, consultation with and/or authority from the respective District Attorney's Office wherein the requesting agency is located may be required.
