Students who are applying from outside UNE should compute their GPAs based on 200 and 300 level Psychology units completed at their institution that match most closely with the UNE core units listed above.

To calculate your Psychology GPA, convert your grades to a numerical scale for the seven core units and one 300 level Psychology coded elective of your choice (i.e., 8 units in total) using the following conversion table. Sum the grade points and divide by 8.

Grade	Grade Point
<b>HD</b>	<b>7</b>
<b>D</b>	<b>6</b>
<b>C</b>	<b>5</b>
<b>P</b>	<b>4</b>

NOTE: If you have completed a unit twice, use only the most recent result for the unit.

Please note that meeting the minimum GPA does not guarantee an offer of a place in Honours. Students who are not successful in obtaining a place in our Honours program will automatically be considered for the Graduate Diploma in Psychology (Advanced).

If your GPA is lower than 5, you do not meet the entry requirements in to the Psychology Fourth year programs. You will need to apply for the Graduate Diploma in Psychology to redo units and boost your GPA.
