RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ☐ 1. Each team must have six (6) persons to a team, 4 pushers, 1 rider, and 1 manager/alternate. All participants must be 18 years of age at a minimum. All participants must sign a Waiver of Liability.
- ☐ 2. Rider must wear an approved helmet.
- ☐ 3. Race course will be 530 yards.
- ☐ 4. Beds will run in heats of 4 teams. Winner from each heat will compete for final prize.
- ☐ 5. The decorating of beds is encouraged; however, each bed must display the Habitat for Humanity logo and the City of Blairsville seal.
- ☐ 6. All beds must be human powered only. No other form of propulsion will be allowed.
- ☐ 7. All beds must be pushed and not pulled.
- ☐ 8. All beds must cross the finish line to be considered for the runoff heat(s).
- ☐ 9. All beds must be 2'x6' at a minimum and not more than 6'x8'.
- ☐ 10. All beds must have a 'mattress' of some form or fashion.
- ☐ 11. All beds must have 4 functioning wheels that must contact the road surface at all times.
- ☐ 12. All beds must pass tech inspection prior to each heat. No exceptions will be allowed. Staff decision prevails.
- ☐ 13. All teams must have a theme and be suitably attired to enhance that theme.
- ☐ 14. All beds must display team name or sponsor and be visible and readable from a distance of 50'.
- ☐ 15. All riders must sit or lay flat and not aid in propulsion.
- ☐ 16. All pushers must be in control of the bed at all times until the finish line and race conclusion.
- ☐ 17. Damage incurred or caused will be the sole responsibility of involved team and not Habitat for Humanity, International or its affiliates.
- ☐ 18. Inter-team interference is not allowed and offenders will be disqualified.
- ☐ 19. No performance enhancing substances, legal or illegal, to include alcoholic beverages will be permitted. Violation will lead to disqualification.
- ☐ 20. Riders must not be tied to the bed. **Snoring is not allowed.** 😊
- ☐ 21. Push bars must not exceed 15" in length.
