

COVID-19 EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR CURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS

The COVID-19 Emergency Assistance fund helps with education-related expenses associated with the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19. This fund is reserved for students who are currently enrolled in a program that met on campus prior to the transition to online classes. At this time the maximum amount of emergency assistance that will be provided by this grant is \$3,000. This funding is limited to students who are eligible to receive federal financial aid. Students are encouraged to apply no later than May 1, 2020.

Note for undergraduate students: If your family's financial circumstances have changed due to a change in income, please submit an Appeal Concerning Expected Contribution through FAST.
