- To develop new technologies, products and services.
- Encourage small & medium enterprise participation in collaborative research.
- Foster partnerships between industry and research organisations.
- Two funding streams for CRC's and CRC-Projects.

CRC-Projects

Closes: Round 2 opened on 18 August and closes on 26 October 2016.

Round 3 expected to open in January 2017.

- Up to 3 years, industry-led collaborative research.
- Up to \$3M grant to be matched with cash & in-kind contributions.
- Cash contributions from industry will be viewed favourably.
- Grant can be used for research, employee salaries & on-costs involved in project, student placements, contract expenditure, commercialisations & regulatory approvals, capital equipment, financial auditing of project, acquiring IP and technology.
- Grant cannot be used for activities or project previously funded through other funding scheme or for indirect support costs of participant staff or reimburse costs committed as in-kind under the Funding Agreement.

Who can apply?

- An industry entity must submit application.
- CRC-Project application requires two Australian industry organisations including one small or medium enterprise (< 200 employees) PLUS an Australian Research Organisation.

Selection criteria

- Expected industry outcomes (30%)
- Proposed research activity (30%).
- Demonstrated governance & management (10%).
- Proposed education and training programme (10%).
- Value for money (10%).
- Expected national benefits (10%).
